Theme title: Infodemia and communication during the pandemic

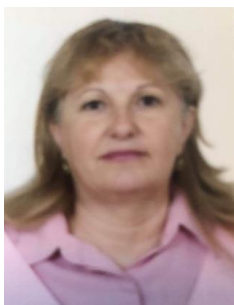

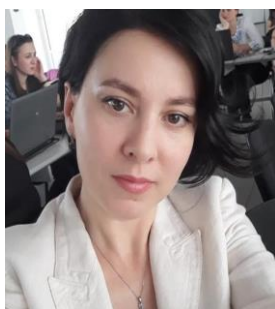

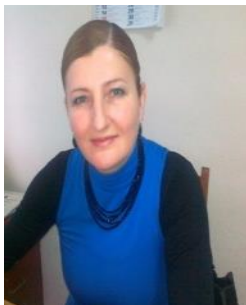
